The Ubuntu Network

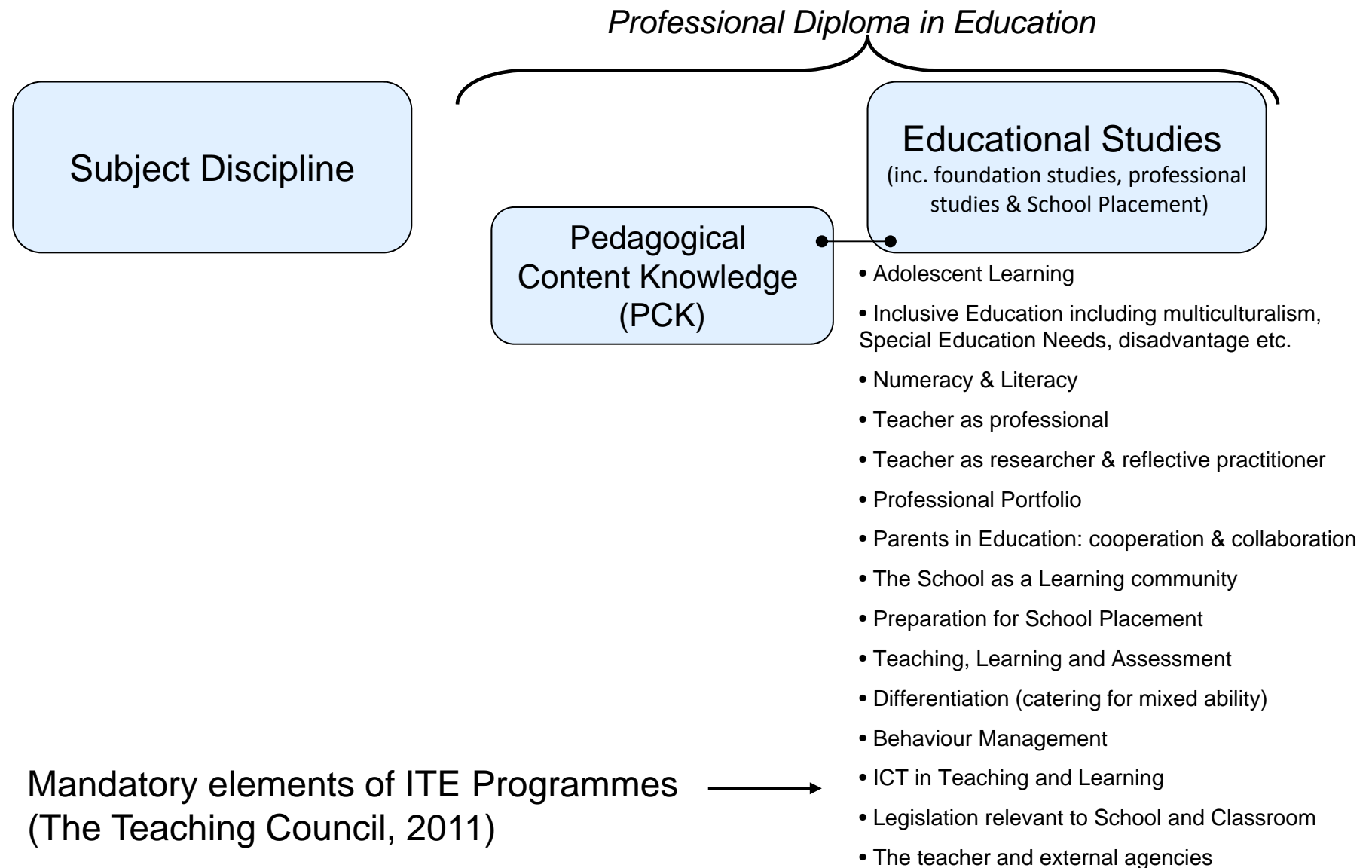
- Community of academics involved in post primary Initial Teacher Education (ITE) across Ireland.

The Challenge, a packed ITE curriculum



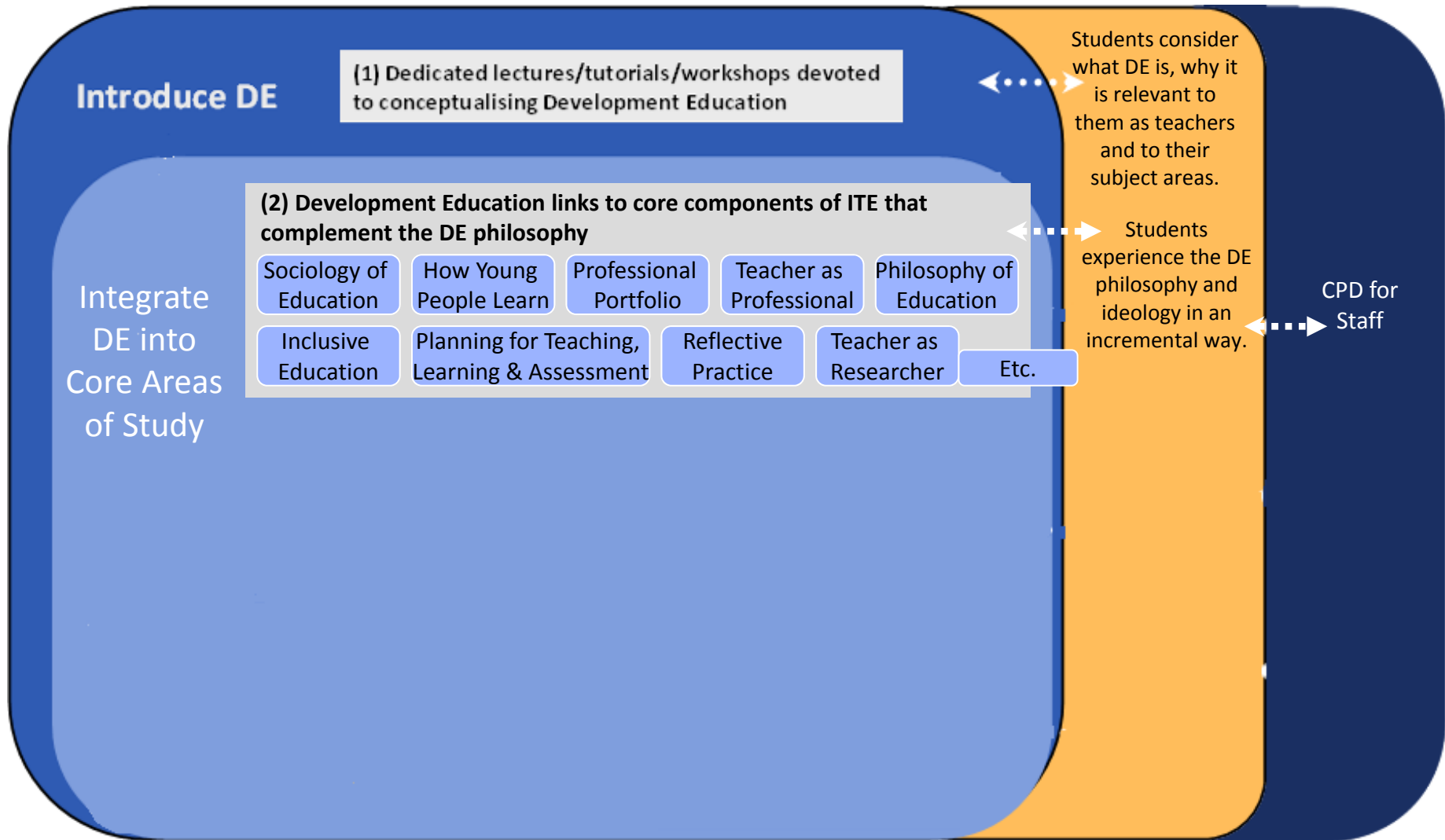

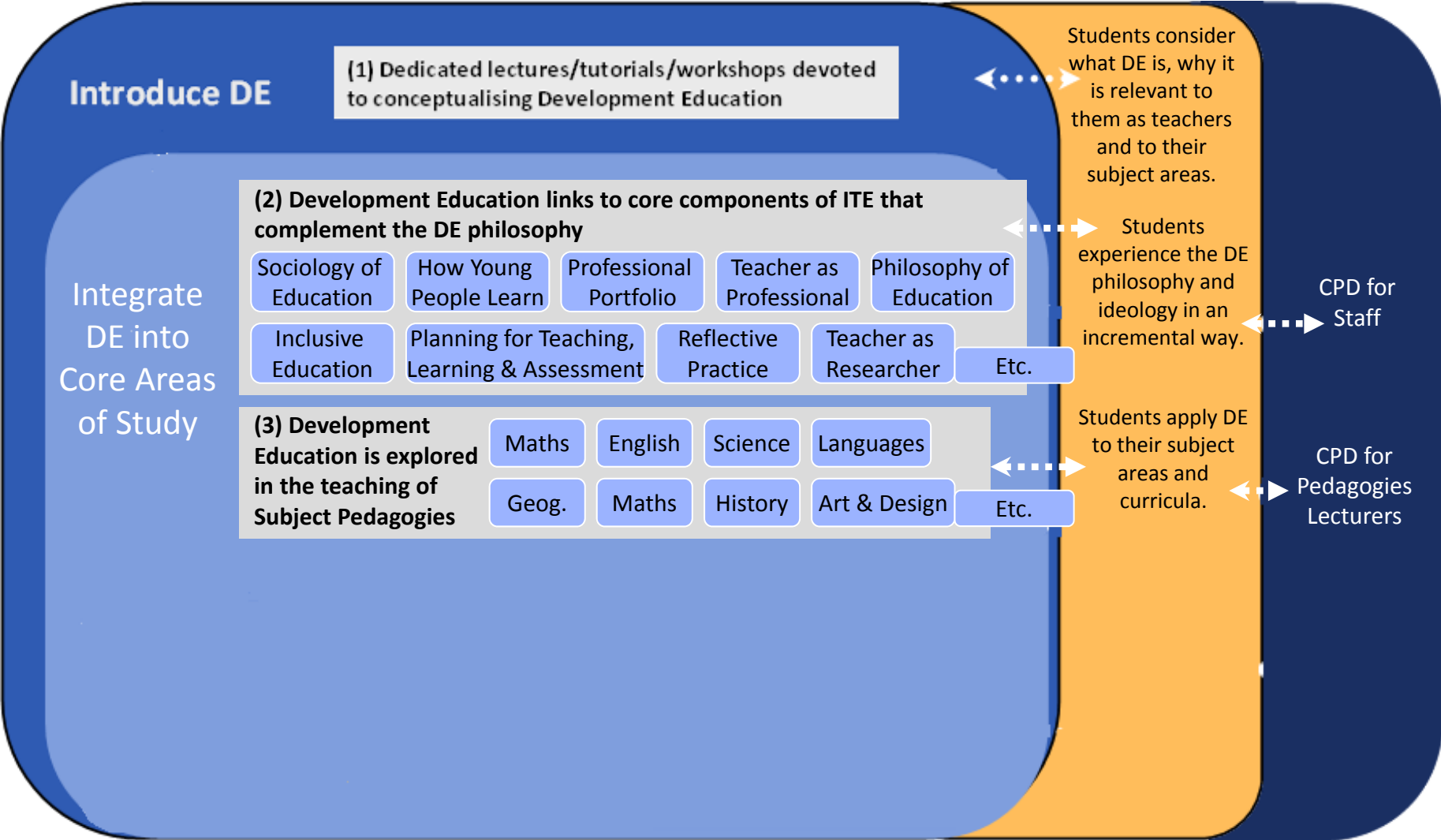

Students consider what DE is, why it is relevant to them as teachers and to their subject areas.

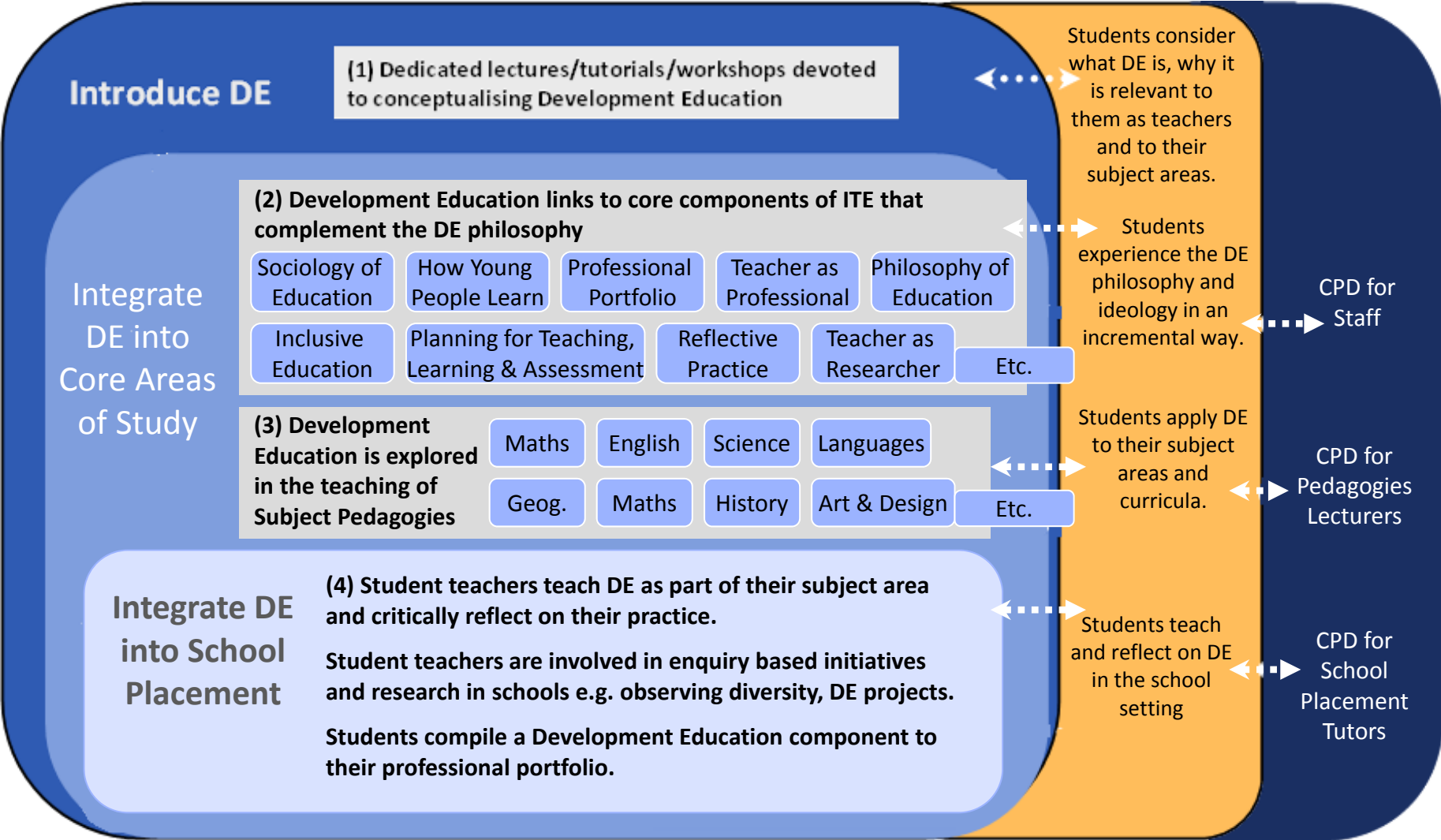
